At CreaNova School, the Batxillerat stage, aimed at students aged 16 to 18, offers a comprehensive education tailored to the needs and interests of each student.

The program is organized into three pathways: Scientific-Technological, Social-Humanistic, and Visual Arts. The flexibility in choosing subjects allows them to personalize their study plan, enhancing both their university preparation and their academic and professional development.


Over the two years of Batxillerat, students continue acquiring tools and strategies to help them grow as responsible individuals and active members of their social environment. The education focuses on strengthening critical thinking and an entrepreneurial spirit, fostering creativity, initiative, teamwork, and self-confidence. To achieve this, activities and presentations that encourage reflection and decision-making are carried out.

In addition to the core subjects of each pathway, students can choose from a variety of subjects in other areas, such as Entrepreneurship, Industrial Technology, Financial Education, European Citizenship, Graphic-Plastic Expression Techniques, Robotics, and Artificial Intelligence. These options provide a wide range of possibilities for personal growth, allowing them to explore their interests and expand their knowledge.

This stage is further enriched with workshops and talks led by specialists, offering students solid academic and professional guidance. This comprehensive education aims to prepare young people to successfully pass university entrance exams (PAU) or other academic assessments while equipping them to build an autonomous and confident identity, open to lifelong learning and exploration.

Below you will find how the stages are organized at CreaNova School and the distribution by grades and ages.




Stage objectives

In the baccalaureate stage, the educational objectives focus on providing students with more specialized and in-depth training, preparing them for higher education and adult life. Some of the most common objectives at this stage are:

- 1. Preparation for higher education:** Its main objective is to prepare students for access to higher education, whether through university or technical and vocational training.
- 2. Development of critical thinking:** The aim is to encourage students to develop the ability to analyze, evaluate, and question information objectively and reflectively.
- 3. Acquisition of specific skills:** Depending on the speciality (Science, Humanities, Arts), students are sought to acquire specific skills and knowledge in their area of interest.
- 4. Promotion of Autonomy and Responsibility:** The aim is for students to take greater responsibility in their learning process and in making decisions about their academic and professional future.
- 5. Development of Research Skills:** The goal is to foster students' ability to research, gather information, and develop academic projects and papers.

6. Improvement of Communication Skills: The development of oral and written communication skills is promoted, as well as teamwork and collaboration.

7. Personal and Social Development: The aim is for students to develop values, attitudes, and competencies that allow them to be responsible, ethical, and committed citizens.

8. Preparation for Adult Life: The goal is for students to acquire skills for everyday life, such as decision-making, time management, and handling social and emotional situations.

These objectives are designed based on the curriculum and educational competencies established by the educational system of Catalonia.

There are efforts to provide official certification options for students' language proficiency, which, along with international interactions and activities, complete their education and prepare them for higher levels.

Simultaneously, in the regulated Secondary and Baccalaureate studies, students at **CreaNova School** can obtain dual international qualifications through the High School Diploma Programme, which facilitates their continuation of studies at universities worldwide.

The Academic and Professional Guidance Program at this stage provides students with tools and strategies for making the right decisions in the future.

Materials

1st and 2nd Baccalaureate students must bring and use their own laptop.

The school is not responsible for items placed in lockers, nor for their replacement in case of loss, damage, theft, etc.

Please remember that the use of mobile phones during school hours is strictly prohibited. Mobile phones can be stored in the designated lockers, with a deposit required.

Tutoring

At **CreaNova School**, teachers act as guides and companions, facilitating opportunities.

Through careful selection of materials and environments, activities and workshops are designed to create connections between students and their surroundings, respecting their freedom and autonomy at all times. The stimulation of multiple skills within a context promotes the development of communicative and linguistic competence with both adults and peers.


The teacher-tutor advises students on their notes, workshops, presentations, and supervises the work done. They prepare and conduct various workshops according to the curriculum and based on students' interests. Tutors collect and share concerns, interests, progress, and development with their students, both individually and in groups, providing constant support and guidance in their daily lives, in volunteer actions, research work, etc..

Each family can request **individual meetings with their child's tutor** whenever needed. Similarly, families may also be summoned by the school (Coordination or Management) when deemed appropriate.

Once the school year begins, each tutor will inform about their availability and visiting hours.

At a minimum, two tutoring sessions will be held per school year.

Tutors will respond to messages or questions from families, considering their availability, provided they are not with the class group, and according to the urgency of the request.



What is our day-to-day like?

These are groups that hold a weekly assembly meeting and have spaces and times for project work, exams, and presentations, in addition to a daily offering of workshop sessions, in which they participate according to their level.

These workshops and workspaces will have requirements for attitude and involvement in the activity and goals that need to be achieved. Punctuality and bringing the necessary materials are very important. Notes will always be taken on paper.

Throughout the week, there will be a set schedule that allows for the necessary routine and daily structure for both the student and to carry out the different dynamics in the various workshops. In this schedule, there is room for free-choice proposals following CreaNova School's philosophy regarding autonomy, flexibility, and time management for the individual.

The student will need to have their own laptop in all areas, as well as the Artificial Intelligence tools (Aleks) and other digital platforms.

In individualized academic monitoring sessions, the tutor will co-evaluate and support the process of achieving objectives for each student, according to their interests and curricular content.

Schedule

Entrance is at 09:00. Punctuality is requested to avoid disrupting the workshops. The door will open at 08:50.

For families who have chosen the **morning child care service**, student entry will be from **08:00**. The door will open at **08:00**.

From **11:00 to 11:30** is snack time for the High school groups. They can bring their own snacks or purchase them at the school cafeteria.

Lunch will be from **14:00 to 15:00**, depending on the assigned shift.

Dismissal is at **16:30** from Monday to Thursday. On Fridays, at **14:00**.

Evaluation

In the competency-based curriculum, assessment plays a regulatory role throughout the learning process, as it must allow for decisions and adaptations of pedagogical strategies according to student characteristics and verify their progress as they advance in learning. It enables teachers to contrast the degree of achievement by students of objectives in subject areas and basic competencies, and to adjust, as necessary, the didactic processes. For students, evaluation also serves as an essential element for learning, as those who perceive their progress and regulate themselves are better prepared to advance in learning and continue learning.

Through ongoing monitoring by tutors and other subject-specialist teachers, through individual work, group projects, presentations, and self-assessment, we achieve **continuous individual assessment** and evaluation not only of needs but also of the acquisition of skills and competencies of each of our students, allowing us to attend to and monitor progress in all areas of knowledge.

Weekly assemblies also enable decisions on project proposals, both from the group and subject-specialist teachers, as well as evaluation of results achieved, conflict resolution, and consensus on agreements.

The **Aleks** artificial intelligence program, among other platforms, provides detailed and timely information on the progress and progression of each student in mathematics, technology, sciences, and languages.

Quarterly, the school compiles a personal report alongside the report card: in December, Easter Week, and June, which will be received through **ADDITIO**, the family-school communication platform.

Services



Cafeteria

The cafeteria service is fully managed by the school, covering both the preparation of balanced menus and the supervision of the service. The school has developed a cafeteria project, incorporating lunchtime as a learning opportunity, as students eat with their tutors.

A well-balanced menu is designed and supervised according to the guidelines of the Generalitat de Catalunya for schools. We continuously strive to improve the quality of our meals by increasing the intake of vegetables and fruits while balancing protein consumption.

We offer a model that integrates nutritional education as part of the Educational Project and the student's daily life.

Each family receives the monthly menu, allowing them to see the different meals offered.

At CreaNova School, we provide different types of menus: regular, vegetarian, gluten-free, and lactose-free. We also accommodate students with food allergies or intolerances, whether temporary or chronic, always under medical prescription and as indicated in the cafeteria registration form.

The cafeteria schedule varies by group, running from 12:00 PM to 2:30 PM.

During the morning, students have designated times and spaces for a snack, which they bring from home. In Elementary, fruit is also provided by the school. We recommend avoiding industrial pastries or highly sugary products and using reusable containers or Boc n' Roll-type wraps. Any plastic waste will be returned home for proper disposal.

Students from **Middle** School and up can purchase food from the school's cafeteria.

At CreaNova School, the cafeteria space and time are also part of the learning process. The principles of our pedagogical approach are applied and experienced in all activities. We foster a relaxed environment where students interact, share experiences, and engage in a social moment of growth, learning, decision-making, and self-responsibility.

To participate in this activity, as in any other, appropriate behavior is required, following the guidelines outlined in the CreaNova School Organizational and Operational Regulations.

Students contribute to the cleaning and maintenance of the cafeteria by tidying up after meals, cleaning tables and floors, and ensuring that any spilled food or drinks are properly cleaned, always with the necessary support from adults.

The dynamics created in this space provide an additional opportunity for the development of emotional and social intelligence, fostering a culture of respect for oneself, others, and the environment.

Bacchlaureate students may choose to eat outside the school but are also welcome to enroll in the school's cafeteria service if they wish.

Extended Care Hours

Morning Care:

Monday to Friday: 8:00 AM to 8:50 AM

Students can arrive at any time from 8:00 AM onwards, and the fee remains the same regardless of the arrival time.

Afternoon Care:

Friday: 2:30 PM to 5:00 PM

Students can be picked up at any time starting from 2:30 PM.

Care, Order, and Cleanliness

At **CreaNova School**, we promote respect, cooperation, and collective care within our shared spaces. All students are responsible for taking care of the infrastructure, furniture, and materials in the school.

CreaNova School belongs to everyone and is for everyone, so special attention is given to maintaining clean and orderly spaces.
