6 CONDITIONS AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



REGISTRATION DEADLINE AND MINIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

- *The registration deadline will be Monday, June 8.*
- *On Friday, June 12, it will be confirmed whether the camp will go ahead.*
- *If you wish to request any changes, you must do so within the established deadline by sending an email to: creanovaschool@playedu.es*
- *A minimum of 25 participants per week will be required.*

PAYMENT AND REFUNDS:

- *Payment method: once the weeks that will take place are confirmed, we will send you a notice with the account number to which the payment must be made.*
- *If the camp registration is cancelled after the registration deadline (June 8) has passed, the cancellation will not be processed.*

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What should I bring to camp?

- *Comfortable clothing, a backpack with a snack and a water bottle (it is recommended not to bring personal belongings to avoid loss or misplacement).*
- *Additionally, they should bring swimwear and a towel for water activities.*

Are there breaks and quiet times during the day?

- *Yes, during snack time and after lunch, there will be free time to chat and play with peers, always under the supervision of the instructors.*

Is there an option to sign up for individual days or incomplete weeks?

- *Yes, there is an option to attend single days. You must complete the registration form and select "Single day (with or without meals)" and indicate the requested day.*

How are drop-off and pick-up managed?

- *Drop-off: Free arrival from 8:00 to 9:00 at no extra cost. Children can be left at "Early Birds" from 8:00. Activities begin at 9:00.*
- *Pick-up (two options): At 14:00 (leaving without lunch) or at 16:00. Instructors will bring the children to the entrance for individual handover in order of arrival. Authorized persons for pick-up must be indicated in the registration form.*

How do you manage allergies, intolerances, and medication?

- *In the registration form, you must fill in the section for Allergies, Illnesses, or Observations if applicable.*
- *The catering service will prepare a menu adapted to allergies and intolerances.*

How are groups organized?

- *Groups will be organized according to the number of participants.*
- *If the minimum number of participants is reached in each stage (Preschool / Primary), separate groups will be created. Otherwise, all participants will be together in one group.*
